

**VILLAGE MAP**



The Parish Council map of the village has now been fixed to the wall of the village hall. **STREET LIGHTING**

The Parish Council's grant application for a new LED street lighting system has been successful and installation work is now in hand, with completion expected within the next few months. This will provide a softer more diffused white light, which is regarded as being more environmentally friendly. It also offers significant cost savings in terms of electricity and maintenance.

**VILLAGE POST OFFICE**

The Village Hall Committee and the Parish Council are actively seeking a resumption of the Post Office service in the village hall, but without any success to date. The Post Office are continuing to approach local Postmasters with a view to one of them taking on the service.

**BOROUGH LOCAL PLAN**

The Borough Council of Kings Lynn and West Norfolk are consulting on their proposed local plan for Syderstone and elsewhere. This phase is mainly concerned with new house building and the proposal is to build on the opposite side of Creake Road to the existing housing. Comments must be submitted by 4 October 2013.

**FOOD CADDY BAGS**

The approved food caddy bags for recycling food waste may be purchased at the village hall on Wednesday mornings between 10 am to 12 noon. The price is £1.60 for a roll of 50 bags.

**DRUG ABUSE (SYDERSTONE COMMON)**

Nitrous Oxide (N<sub>2</sub>O), also known as laughing gas, is the second most widely used substance for drug abuse. It comes in silver metal cartridges about 2" long, which are used to blow up balloons and the gas is inhaled from the balloon. If a full cartridge is inadvertently dropped and left in direct sunlight it becomes unstable and liable to explode and could start a fire. Evidence of used cartridges and balloons is being found on Syderstone Common. If you come across this litter, or have any other relevant information, please contact the local beat officer PCSO Owen James (Tel: 101).

## NIGHT NOISE HELICOPTERS

During the hot weather it was difficult enough to get to sleep without aircraft noise at night. Following complaints from residents, the Parish Chairman contacted the MoD and spoke to the Range Officer for Sculthorpe air field.



The offending aircraft was a V-22 Osprey helicopter with twin tilt rotors. For take off and landing the two rotors spin horizontally like a helicopter, but in flight they tilt vertically like an aircraft, thus it is both a helicopter and an aircraft. It is the planned replacement for the US Blackhawk helicopter.

The problem was that the down exhaust wash on landing and takeoff is so hot that in the dry weather it would set fire to dry grass and heathland. Thus exercises were restricted to Harrier Strips and concrete runways such as Sculthorpe, which is why we experienced more nuisance than normal.
