The village defibrillator is now installed and working. It is situated on the outside wall of the village hall to the right of the front door.

In the case of a medical emergency, such as a heart attack, stroke or severe difficulty in breathing, the procedure is as follows.

Call for an ambulance by dialling:

999

Once the ambulance is arranged, hang up the phone and then dial:

01485 205100

The second telephone number above is the Village Emergency Telephone (VET). It will ring all of the volunteers simultaneously. The first person to answer the phone will deal with your call and all the other phones will stop ringing. If the first person to answer your call cannot help, e.g. the volunteer is at work and his/her partner answers the phone, then that person will dial the VET number again and it will ring all the remaining numbers, and so on until an available volunteer is located. Then a volunteer who has been trained in the use of the defibrillator will arrive with it at the premises.

SYDERSTONE POST CODES

Finding a property quickly in a rural village can be time consuming, so when calling for an ambulance, it is important to give the correct address and its post code.

MR TURNER (12A)

Mike Leigh's biography of the British artist J.W.W. Turner, played by Timothy Spall and a repertory of fine character actors. This is one of the most anticipated British films of the year, receiving five star reviews on its release.

Timothy Spall delivers a majestic performance, arguably his best in a rich career, capturing both Turner's quicksilver intelligence and energy but also his coarse manners. Possibly director Leigh's best film to date, and in some ways his most personal.

THE HUNDRED FOOT JOURNEY (PG)

Lasse Hallström (*Chocolat*) directs a charming comedy drama adapted from the novel by Richard C Morais. Helen Mirren holds her nose in the air as Madame Mallory, the snooty owner of a Michelin-starred restaurant in rural France who is very unhappy to catch a waft of curry when Papa (Om Puri) and his brood open for business across the road. A game of one-upmanship ensues, as each tries to get punters through their door. But when the prodigious culinary talent of Papa's son Hassan (Manish Dayal) catches Madame's attention, a bridge starts to be built between the two. Elegant and highly enjoyable film.
