Chairman was pleased to advise that NCC has approved the 50% grant for the Mill Lane TROD.

Jack's Lane CLG Report
 Cllr Taylor reported on the recent meeting of the Community Liaison Group (CLG). A Funding
 Committee to be set up to review grant applications, it is hoped that funding will be available
 in May/June.

10. Jack's Lane Road Closures (continued)

Chairman explained that further road closures will take place as follows:-

C479 Burnham Road (known locally as Barwick Road) from its junction with B1454 Fakenham Road eastwards to its junction with U22193 Barwick Road and U22193 Barwick Road from its junction with C479 Burnham Road northwards to its junction with U22192 South Creake Road in the PARISH OF BARWICK. The roads will be temporarily closed (except for access) between 07.30 hrs to 17.30 hrs from 16 March to 20 March and 23 March to 27 March 2015 (Mondays to Fridays only) for the duration of the works, expected to be about 10 days within the period.

Alternative route is via B1454 Fakenham Road, B1115 Bircham Road.

11. Norman Way Letter and Petition

Chairman explained the letter and petition received from residents in Norman Way regarding parking on the grass area owned by Freebridge Community Housing. He further explained the official parking spaces available and the sign erected by Freebridge stating 'No cars on grassed area'. Following detailed discussion it was **Resolved that the Clerk writes to the relevant residents confirming that the Parish Council supports the actions taken by Freebridge and that the pot hole in Mill Lane is the responsibility of NCC Highways.**

12. Review of Norfolk County Council's Committee System of Governance Chairman referred to the letter received from NCC which invited our comments on the effectiveness of the new Committee System of Governance. **Resolved no comments to be made.**

- 13. Cllr Chenery of Horsburgh report
 - Cllr Chenery reported as follows:-
 - 13.1 Central Government has ruled that no charges will be made for domestic waste disposal at local refuse sites.
- 14. To Receive Correspondence
 - 14.1 Letter from E.On regarding changes to electricity charges from 1 May 2015. Chairman advised that we have received notification from E.On that their electricity charges will be increasing by 35% from 1 May 2015. Clerk has already requested quotations from three other electricity providers and details awaited. Cllr MacArthur suggested that we complain to the electricity Regulator regarding the substantial increases. **Resolved Clerk to send letter**.
