- 2. Parishioner's Time None present.
- 3. Declarations of Interest None.
- Minutes of the July Parish Council Meeting held on 16 July 2015
   Minutes of the above meeting had been circulated. Resolved to approve the Minutes.
- 5. Ongoing Items from the Minutes
  - 5.1 Lime Tree Email from Mr R Miller, Houghton Hall Estate, dated 2 September 2015 Chairman read out the e-mail which advised that Houghton Hall Estate confirm that the tree is in satisfactory condition, has recently been pruned and the tree guard will be removed shortly.
  - 5.2 Beech Tree Letter from Mrs Libby Rutter, Ringer Trust, dated 12 August 2015 Chairman read out the letter which stated that the Ringer Trust does not own the Beech Tree.
- 6. Financial matters
  - 6.1 Chairman and Cllr Ms Thompson signed the bank statements.
  - 6.2 Chairman explained the Receipts and Payments Spreadsheet April to September 2015. The projected out-turn for 2015/16 is a reserves balance of £6800 (assuming £1800 VAT reclaimed this financial year)
  - 6.3-6 "Financial Matters" attached. **Resolved to agree all balances and approve payments**.
- 7. Community Asset Register

Chairman advised that he has received recent news that a new landlord may have been found for the Lynn Arms. Cllr Bateman understands that the pub is hoping to reopen in two weeks time.

8. Playground Inspection Report (grass reinstated Springers and Wendy House) and Playground Work in Progress

Chairman confirmed that all works have been completed. The installation date for the Roundabout is the 8 October 2015.

9. Budget – Review of Outside Memberships

Chairman explained that a review of current subscriptions and grants is recommended in an attempt to reduce expenditure. Cllr Taylor agreed to circulate the Great Massingham Community Cars Report to all Councillors in order to review this expenditure. Resolved to review the subscriptions for membership to Norfolk Playing Field Association and Community Action Norfolk when setting next year's budget.

Chairman suggested that in future the Parish Council could consider charging a hire fee for the playing field in order to increase income.

10. Future Grant Applications – Rudham Road TROD £478 (50%), Goals & Nets £807, See saw £1248

Chairman reported that under the current rules the TROD cannot be funded by a grant from the Jack's Lane Wind Farm Fund. He welcomed further ideas for any other equipment for the playing field. Resolved apply to NCC for funding 50% under the Parish Partnership Scheme for the TROD and to apply to NCF (Jack's Lane Wind Farm Fund) for the goals, nets and see saw.

11. Community Speed Watch

The Parish Council supports a Community Speed Watch Scheme. Resolved Clir Bateman and Clir MacArthur agreed to make the necessary arrangements.

12. Parish Council Archives

Chairman advised that he holds a number of archives dating back to 1894. **Resolved to pass these records to the village archivists when they are ready to receive them.** 

13. External Auditor's Report

Chairman was pleased to report that the Parish Council Accounts passed the external audit.

  - 14.1 Local Plans

Chairman reported that BCKLWN's Local Plan has not been adopted. The meeting received and noted the correspondence from North Norfolk District Council regarding Notification of Intention to prepare a new Local Plan.

- 14.2 Planning Application:- New Dwelling and Cart Shed at Churchgate Cottage, The Street, Syderstone (previously circulated) Reference Number 15/01186/F Clerk confirmed that the objection to this Planning Application was submitted on 11 August 2015.
- 14.3 Planning Appeal: The Stores, Ashside, Syderstone Reference number 15/00757/F Received and noted at the meeting.
- 15. Cllr Chenery of Horsburgh report

Chairman reported on behalf of Cllr Chenery that NCC propose to close Docking Recycling Centre and to reduce the opening times of Heacham Recycling Centre to four days per week. Concerns were expressed by all Councillors of this proposal. Resolved Clerk to write to the Leader of the Conservative Group and the Leader of the UKIP and Independent Group expressing our concerns and to ask the Groups to maintain the services.
