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1. Apologies for Absence

2. Parishioner's Time  
In preparation for the WW1 Centenary Commemorations a parishioner had started a 'Just Giving Page' asking all parishioners to support the purchase of a 'Tommy' silhouette. The parishioner informed the Parish Council that £802 has been raised and the silhouette has been ordered and will be delivered in approximately two weeks' time. The appropriate permission has been granted by the Highways Department and the silhouette will be placed on the Village Green for four weeks. The Parish Council joined the Chair in expressing their appreciation to the parishioner.

Non-material amendment to planning permission has been withdrawn.

18/01829/F Variation of condition 2 of planning permission - First floor extension over flat roof. Application considered at the meeting. **Resolved to make no comments.**

7. Cllr Chenery of Horsburgh Report

8. Playground Inspection Report  
Security to Gate. Further consideration was given to the purchase of a new lock but concerns were raised that the emergency services would be unable to gain access to the playground. **Resolved not to proceed with a lock.**
9. Adult Exercise Equipment – Update  
Cllr Niemann handed round brochures at the meeting showing the proposed equipment and discussions took place about the size of the proposed area. The Parish Council joined Cllr Bateman in thanking Cllr Niemann for all the work put into this project. **Resolved to invite all interested parishioners to join the Parish Councillors at 9am on Sunday 21<sup>st</sup> October to view the size and positioning of the proposed area.**
10. Deeds to Norman Way Playground – Update Land Registry with Parish Clerks address. **Resolved to instruct Hayes and Storr Solicitors to make the necessary changes at a cost of £75.00**
11. The Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014. Public Spaces Protection Order (Control of Dogs) – Borough Council of King's Lynn and West Norfolk 2015 Play Areas – **Exclusion of Dogs**. The above Order expires on December 1<sup>st</sup> 2018 and will be replaced with The Anti-social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014. The Public Spaces Protection Order (Control of Dogs) – Borough Council of King's Lynn and West Norfolk 2018. Discussions took place about the new Order which includes all enclosed children's play areas in the Borough and this Order comes into force on **1<sup>st</sup> December 2018** for a period of 3 years.
12. Road Closure with the B1155 Stanhoe Road for resurfacing works  
The Parish Council had been informed that Norfolk County Council proposed to make a Temporary Traffic Order affecting the B1153 Docking Road/Lynn Road from a distance 35 metres north of its junction with the B1155 Stanhoe Road for a distance of 65 metres southwards in the PARISH OF BIRCHAM because of resurfacing works. The road will be temporarily closed (except for access) on 22<sup>nd</sup> October 2018 for the duration of the works, expected to be 1 day. It was noted that the resurfacing works are taking place and the road has been closed for approximately one week before the current Parish Meeting.
