1. Apologies for Absence

2. Parishioner's Time
Three Parishioners raised concerns about damage to parked cars on The Street by vehicles speeding through the village. This problem has previously been reported to the Parish Council who forwarded their concerns to Norfolk County Council's Highways Department, unfortunately the damage to cars still continues. The suggestion to reduce the speed limit to 20 mph and asking NCC to carry out a survey and put forward their recommendations within a public meeting, were discussed. **Resolved Clerk to write to NCC Highways Section raising concerns and asking for their recommendations.**

 - 5.2 19/00184/F Demolition of existing bungalow and annex, and construction of a pair of semi-detached, two storey, open market dwellings at Arwyn 13 Ashside Syderstone, Norfolk PE31 8RZ

 - 5.3 18/01917/F Land west of Broadlands, Docking Road, Erection of 5 dwellings - Application Permitted, 7 Feb 2019, Delegated Decision Received and noted at the meeting.

7. Cllr Chenery of Horsburgh Report

8. Damage to children's playground safety barrier by a reversing vehicle.
NCC's Highways Department were notified and work is to be carried out within the next six weeks.
9. Four Winds Junction proposed roundabout (B1454/A148)
Cllr. Chenery of Horsburgh has discussed this with NCC's Highways Department and further meetings will take place after Cllr. Askew has obtained accident statistics from the Police.
10. Concrete plinth for 'Tommy' silhouette for Armistice Day 2019
Detailed specifications are required for an application to be made for a concrete plinth on the village green to secure the 'Tommy' silhouette in place. **Resolved Cllr Niemann to discuss specifications with the parishioner who originated the 'Just Giving Page'.**
11. Bus Shelter Notice Board (Management)
The notice board has proved a popular addition in keeping parishioners aware of activities within the village. Discussions took place that supported advertising activities within the wider localities as far as King's Lynn and Cromer but it was highlighted that commercial advertising will be removed. **Resolved that items of local and wider interest can be posted but if space is at a premium then the emphasis is on activities within the village.**
12. Newsletter advert vacancy
There is currently one vacancy for advertising on the back page of the village newsletter and the Chair discussed all companies on the waiting list. **Resolved to promote the advising space for local individuals/companies and the vacancy has now been filled.**
13. Public Space Protection Order (PSPO) dogs.
The Order which came into force on **1st December 2018** for a period of 3 years will be highlighted in the next village newsletter and a supply of A6 adhesive Dog Fouling notices have been received from the Borough Council of King's Lynn and West Norfolk and these will be placed around the village.
14. Correspondence – Keep Britain Tidy Campaign
In support of the Great British Spring Clean 22nd March to 23rd April 2019, there will be a tidy up around the village - further information and the time and date will shortly be displayed in the Parish Council noticeboards.
