## VILLAGE SPEED WATCH

As the morning and evenings draw out, we are beginning to do our weekly speed watch sessions. We would like to do two per week, but we do need more volunteers.

Villagers cannot have failed to notice that drivers still go much too fast through Syderstone, so if you can volunteer just one hour per week (or fortnight), it would be greatly appreciated.

This season we shall also have the community speed watch officer with us on a number of occasions. People caught speeding when he is present will receive a fine and 3 points on their licence, rather than the mandatory letter that is usually sent.

## **PUBLIC SPACE PROTECTION ORDER**

The Borough Council has issued a Public Space Protection Order (PSPO) under the Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime & Policy Act 2014, which applies to all land to which the public has access within the Borough of Kings Lynn and West Norfolk. There are two aspects to the order, which relates to dogs:

1. If a dog messes in any public area, then the owner must clean up after the dog.
2. No dogs are allowed in any children's playground. It is an offence to take or allow a dog into any children's playground

Upon conviction the maximum fine for either offence is Level 3 on the magistrate scale, i.e. £1000.

The reason for this is that dog faeces carry harmful infections, commonly known as Toxocariasis, which can cause eye disorders, dizziness, nausea, asthma and epileptic fits. Young children are particularly vulnerable, especially to damage to their eyes.

With the aid of donations from local businesses and residents, the Parish Council has installed dog waste bins at the three entrances to Syderstone Common and on the Creake Road access to Womack Wood.
